MARRIAGE LICENSES

To be married in the state of Indiana a couple must have a marriage license. The applicants who wish to be married must apply in person in the Jay County Clerk's office and bring with them the required documents. For Indiana residents, at least one applicant must reside in Jay County and provide documentation of residency. Out-of-State residents may apply for a license in Jay County only if the marriage ceremony is performed in Jay County.

<u>Documentation:</u>

- 1. Valid driver's license or ID card or a copy of your birth certificate.
- 2. If previously married, the date and how the previous marriage ended.
- 3. Names and birthdates of any children the applicants may have.
- 4. Your mother's maiden name.
- 5. Parents last known address & state of birth.

Marriage licenses are good for 60 days from date of issue and the cost is \$29.00. This will include 1 (one) free certified copy of the license after it is recorded with the state that is mailed to the applicants. Cost for out-

of-state residents will be \$69.00, which also includes 1 (one) certified copy of the license after recorded with the state that is mailed to the applicants.
